Tipp City Schools learned one of its student-athletes has tested positive for coronavirus (COVID-19).

The district has not received any reports of other students, coaches, or staff members experiencing illnesses with symptoms resembling those of coronavirus.

The district is working closely with Miami County Public Health to identify all students who may have come in contact with their classmate. Miami County Public Health will communicate with these families.

These students will quarantine for 14 days as recommended by the CDC and Miami County Public Health.

The district will comply with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) and the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) to maintain the privacy of our students and staff.

We are closely monitoring this situation and will provide updates as warranted.
