2020 Fall Athletic Ticketing Policies

Tipp City Community,

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic and in accordance with policy outlined by the Ohio Department of Health, seating capacity and ticket sales at all Tippecanoe Athletic Events will be limited. COVID-19 face coverings will be required for admittance for all spectators.

Varsity Football

Only students participating in the Friday night event will be eligible to purchase tickets. Spectator attendance will be capped at 375 people.

Ticket sales will be limited to participants from the following groups:

- The following students will be permitted to purchase 2 tickets per home game
 - Football players on the active roster for that game (60 players)
 - Football Coaches (1 ticket each)
 - Varsity Cheer (13 members)
 - Marching Band (2 tickets per senior and one ticket for everybody else)
 - In accordance with MVL rules, the visiting team will be allotted 75 tickets

All of the above will need to purchase their ticket(s) in the Athletic Office before the end of the school day on Wednesday. Due to the current restrictions parents will not be able to come into the building to purchase tickets. It is our recommendation that each student-athlete purchase their full allotment of tickets. The distribution of those tickets is at the discretion of each athlete and their family. Athletes who lose their ticket will not be issued a second ticket. All presale tickets, adult and student, will cost \$5. Unfortunately only spectators holding a ticket will be admitted. No MVL passes will be accepted. No passes (including staff passes and senior citizen passes) will be accepted this season. **No tickets will be available at the gate for varsity football this year.**

All spectators will be required to wear a face covering to be admitted to the event and will be expected to socially distance by household and wear face coverings in accordance with current public health mandates.

MS Football/JV/9th Football & HS Soccer

- Spectator attendance will be capped at 375
- All tickets will be sold at the gate
 - HS Event Student Tickets \$4, MS Event Student Tickets \$3
 - HS Event Adult Tickets \$6, MS Event Adult Tickets \$5
 - All athletes will have access to 4 tickets
 - Spectators will be required to wear a face covering to be admitted
 - Spectators will be expected to socially distance by household and wear face coverings in accordance with current public health mandates
 - Spectators may be asked to leave the facility following the game they are there to watch in order to create more space for the next grade level game

HS/MS Volleyball

- Spectator attendance will be capped at 300 at THS and 64 at TMS
- For HS Volleyball each player will have access to 4 tickets
- For MS Volleyball each player will have access to 2 tickets
- All tickets will be sold at the gate
 - HS Event Student Tickets \$4, MS Event Student Tickets \$3
 - HS Event Adult Tickets \$6, MS Event Adult Tickets \$5
- Spectators will be required to wear a face covering to be admitted
- Spectators will be expected to socially distance by household and wear face coverings in accordance with current public health mandates

Due to fluid nature of athletic schedules, amidst COVID-19, we have made the difficult decision to not sell individual or season passes for this fall. We have also been forced to discontinue accepting district senior passes. The Governor's Order mandates that the maximum number of tickets, for each participant, will be FOUR. Due to maximum seating capacities, not all events will get that maximum number. We greatly appreciate the community support offered to our students who perform and we long for the opportunity to bring thousands in our community together again for Friday night football and other athletic events. Until then, our focus will be providing opportunities for the families of our students to watch them perform. Tippecanoe Athletics greatly appreciates your understanding of these changes as we all work together to provide maximum participation opportunities for all of our student activities in this time.
